Chapter 122 of City Code: PERMITS REQUIRED: "Any person engaging in peddling, soliciting, or in the business of a transient merchant in the City without first obtaining a license as herein provided is in violation of this chapter." Please note the exceptions in 122.17. Please ask before assuming an exception will be granted.

Applications must be submitted not less than 10 business days prior to the proposed start date of the activity. The City reserves the right to reject any applications that have not been timely submitted to the City. The City shall have the discretionary right to accept an application made less than 10 business days prior to the desired start date.

If there is not enough time in the next tier, the applicant shall pay for the next shortest tier (i.e. if a vendor seeks a one-week license in January, and comes in September for another license, they shall pay for another one week license since there is less than six months before the anniversary date of the first permit).
